Most stores do not publicly advertise their student discount, and the discount is often spread through word-of-mouth. By asking the sale associate, students can be confident that they will get the best discount possible. Here is a student discount list that offers deals just for students:

- Adobe: Students save 60% on Creative Cloud.
- Allstate: Students under that age of 25 can save up to 20% for getting good grades.
- <u>Amazon Student</u>: Free Amazon Prime trial for 6 months; includes delivery benefits, as well as exclusive ways to shop and stream.
- AMC Theatres: Show your student ID on Thursdays and get movie ticket discounts.
- Amtrak: Students ages 13-25 with a valid student ID can save 15% on the lowest Value or Flexible Fare when booking their travel at least 3 days in advance.
